

Sustainable Procurement Policy

Chememan Public Company Limited (the “Company”) places importance on environmental protection, the efficient use of natural resources, greenhouse gas reduction, social responsibility, and good corporate governance. Therefore, the Company has established this Sustainable Procurement Policy to serve as a guideline for conducting business in alignment with the Company’s Sustainability Development Policy. The Company promotes sustainable procurement practices to support government environmental management approaches and contribute to sustainable production and consumption in society.

The Company has established the Sustainable Procurement Policy with the following objectives:

1. To ensure that procurement activities are conducted with suppliers that operate based on social and environmental responsibility, respect human rights, and promote equality. Suppliers are expected to comply with ethical business practices and good corporate governance, while ensuring fair, transparent, and auditable procurement processes (Social and Governance).
2. To ensure that procurement activities are conducted with suppliers that recognize the importance of business sustainability and consider key factors including quality, price, and service to maximize value for the Company (Economic).
3. To ensure that procurement activities are conducted with suppliers that promote and support environmentally friendly operations and consider environmental impacts, while complying with applicable laws, regulations, requirements, rules, and relevant standards (Environmental).
4. The Company aims to build strong relationships with suppliers, promote continuous development, and assess supplier risks covering economic, social, and environmental aspects.

This Policy shall apply to all business units within the Company and shall be communicated to relevant stakeholders to ensure awareness, understanding, and consistent implementation in accordance with the established guidelines.

This Policy shall be effective from 1 July 2024 onwards.
